Scope of Work – Additional items added

Along with the AHU replacements and improved control of the makeup air for the Medical School Building, we are also providing replacements and upgrades of the exhaust system components and controls. Included in this scope is the replacement of butterfly dampers with opposed blade dampers, the replacement of pneumatic actuators with DDC actuators, addition of UPS systems to serve the exhaust controls to ensure constant operation during a power outage, and changes of the system's sequence of operation based on a wind study performed by CPP.

- All schedules must include time for submittals and delivery time of long lead items.
- All schedules must include 10% float of the total project schedule as directed by the UGC.
- Contractor must include 30 days between Substantial Completion and Final Completion per the UGC.

Time is of the essence in the performance of Contractor's duties. Failure of the Contractor to notify UTHealth sufficiently in advance of inability to complete within the delivery schedule, shall grant UTHealth the option of imposing liquidated damages in the amount of fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) per calendar day. Notwithstanding the foregoing, UTHealth shall have no obligation to accept late performance or waive timely performance by Contractor.

6.3 University's Payment Terms

Section 51.012, Education Code, authorizes University to make payments through electronic funds transfer methods. Respondent agrees to accept payments from University through those methods, including the automated clearing house system (ACH). Respondent agrees to provide Respondent's banking information to University in writing on Respondent letterhead signed by an authorized representative of Respondent. Prior to the first payment, University will confirm Respondent's banking information. Changes to Respondent's bank information must be communicated to University in writing at least thirty (30) days before the effective date of the change and must include an IRS Form W-9 signed by an authorized representative of Respondent.

University, an agency of the State of Texas, is exempt from Texas Sales & Use Tax on goods and services in accordance with <u>Section 151.309</u>, <u>Tax Code</u>, and <u>Title 34 TAC Section 3.322</u>. Pursuant to <u>34 TAC Section 3.322(c)(4)</u>, University is not required to provide a tax exemption certificate to establish its tax exempt status.
