



## **Joint Certificate in Dental Informatics**

## **HOW TO APPLY**

Applicants for the Dental Informatics Program are considered based on a **completed application** and the following criteria: For the application, select Graduate Dental Hygiene as the school.

- DDS, DMD, BDS, BDM, BSDH degree or higher or currently enrolled in DDS, DMD, MSDH degree or higher;
- Grade-point average of 3.0 or higher;
- One letter of reference:
- Resume and/or curriculum vitae;
- Personal interview (when requested by the department);
- \*TOEFL for applicants who are nationals of countries where English is not the primary language

Applications are accepted from January 1st to April 30th for the following Fall semester.

Applicants who are already UTSD students should complete the residency application, write a personal statement about why they want to do the program, and interview with the committee.

- 1. For this certificate program, we will **not** sponsor any visa.
- 2. Candidate shall provide evidence that the students are fluent in English as <u>demonstrated by a minimum of 565 points</u> on the Test of English as a Foreign Language ("TOEFL") on the paper-based exam or a minimum of 225 on the Computer-based TOEFL exam, or 86 in the Internet Based TOEFL
