

Joint Certificate in Dental Informatics

HOW TO APPLY

Applicants for the Dental Informatics Program are considered based on a [completed application](#) and the following criteria: For the application, select Graduate Dental Hygiene as the school.

- DDS, DMD, BDS, BDM, BSDH degree or higher or currently enrolled in DDS, DMD, MSDH degree or higher;
- Grade-point average of 3.0 or higher;
- One letter of reference;
- Resume and/or curriculum vitae;
- Personal interview (when requested by the department);
- *TOEFL for applicants who are nationals of countries where English is not the primary language

Applications are accepted from [September 15](#) for the following Fall semester.

Applicants who are already UTSD students should complete the residency application, write a personal statement about why they want to do the program, and interview with the committee.

1. For this certificate program, we will not sponsor any visa.
- *2. Candidate shall provide evidence that the students are fluent in English as demonstrated by a minimum of 565 points on the Test of English as a Foreign Language (“TOEFL”) on the paper-based exam or a minimum of 225 on the Computer-based TOEFL exam, or 86 in the Internet Based TOEFL.
