

MD/PHD SECONDARY APPLICATION



The Secondary Application is required for individuals applying to the MD/PhD program **only** at McGovern Medical School. Individuals who are also applying to the MD program through TMDSAS **do not** need to complete the secondary application.

SECONDARY APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Complete and sign secondary application.
2. Pay application fee - \$65.00
 - You can either print out the application and mail in with a check
 - Checks should be made payable to McGovern Medical School Office of Admissions.
 - OR**
 - Email your completed application and pay fee by credit card over the phone. *There is a \$3.00 transaction fee charged.*

Your secondary application will **not** be processed until payment is received.

The secondary application and fee must be post-marked by **November 1** and must be received by **November 15**. This information is **required** to complete the application process.
