Course Objective

Material Covered:

This elective will provide a thorough introduction to the basic principles of gynecologic oncology. Participants will become familiar with the principles and techniques of chemotherapy, radiotherapy, and surgery. This will be accomplished by direct participation in each of these areas of patient treatment. Participants' level of responsibility will be commensurate with their desire and experience. Flexibility to design a program tailored to the needs and goals of each participant will be allowed.

Skills Acquired:

Students will develop skills in the screening and diagnosis of gynecologic tumors (physical examination, colposcopy, and biopsy techniques. Students will be able to differentiate neoplastic (or treatment-related) alterations from normal findings. Students may also have the opportunity to perform other minor diagnostic or therapeutic procedures such as paracentesis and thoracentesis. They may also have an opportunity to develop some basic surgical skills.
