# Fourth Year Schedule One45 Lottery Guide

The instructions below detail the process for reviewing and making your selections for the fourth year scheduling lotteries. Each independent section will be its own distinct lottery. For the Priority 1 & Priority 2 sections only, you will be contacted if your priority is not available. You will be given the opportunity to make an alternate selection before we move to the next lottery section.

In the sections below you will select your:

- Priority 1 and Priority 2 Rotations: they may include Required courses (APC, RCC, or Required Ambulatory), electives, or vacation
- Your Required Critical Care and Required Ambulatory courses if not previously chosen as a priority

Lottery sections will be run in the order in which they appear in the instructions below.

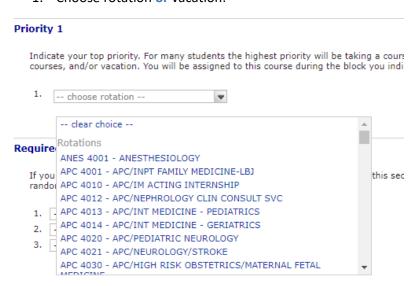
**NOTE**: there is no guarantee that you will receive either of your priority choices so choose wisely; strategically placing a required course as your priority course may not be effective in all circumstances. In all other sections that follow the priority sections, it is in your best interest to provide as many choices as possible.

**Required Courses**: If your preferences have been reviewed for availability and the lottery does not successfully enroll you in a course, you will be moved to the bottom of the list to be randomized into an available section of that course.

Please select your top priority as shown below:

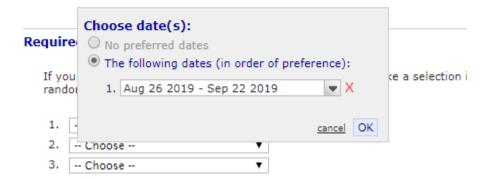

# **Required Critical Care**

If you did not include Required Critical Care as one of your priorities, please make your selection in this section. You may choose up to five blocks, and it is in your best interest to do so – if the system cannot enroll you in a course based on your selections you will be moved to the bottom of the randomized list and enrolled in a block which is open on your schedule and available for the course.

# **Required Ambulatory Medicine**

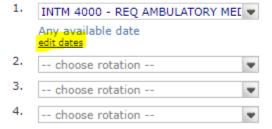
If you did not include a choice for Required Ambulatory Medicine as one of your priorities, please make your selection in this section. You may choose up to four specialties and as many block choices for each as you deem necessary. Again, it is in your best interest to do so – if the system cannot enroll you in a course based on your selections you will be moved to the bottom of the randomized list and enrolled in a block which is open on your schedule and available for the course.

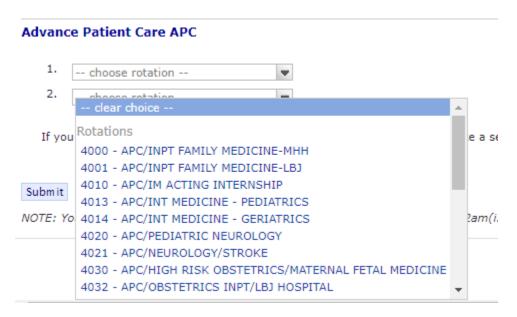

## **Advanced Patient Care**

Unlike the Required Critical Care and Required Ambulatory sections where you must have a selection on your schedule at the end of the lottery, you will **not** be randomly assigned to an available APC if your preferences are not available. If you do not receive your preferred APC selection, you will have to enroll in an available APC during open enrollment which begins on April 4, 2022.

The process of making your selections is similar to previous sections. Note that in the second selection below, we indicated "All Remaining Dates" which will randomly select an available period for the indicated APC selection.

# **Electives**

Electives are not scheduled through the lottery **unless** they were granted as your Priority 1 or Priority 2. You must self-enroll in your electives once open enrollment begins on April 4, 2022. Instructions on how to self-enroll will be sent out closer to open enrollment.

Open enrollment has no end date, you will be able to add/drop courses up until the start of Block 12 if necessary.
