Course Objective

Material Covered:

This third-year elective will introduce students to the field of pediatric cardiology. Students will develop their ausculatory skills such that they will be able to differentiate functional or innocent murmurs from those associated with organic heart disease. Students will become familiar with a variety of data used in the diagnosis of cardiology problems as well as begin to understand how to organize clinical information in pediatric cardiology for the purposes of diagnosis and treatment.

Specific learning objectives for this third-year elective are as follows:

By the end of this elective, the student will be able to:

- · Use ausculatory skills to distinguish functional or innocent murmurs from those associated with organic heart disease
- Interpret ECGs and chest x-rays
- Describe the basic principles of specialized cardiac studies such as echocardiography, cardiac catheterization, and cineangiography
- Organize clinical information in pediatric cardiology for diagnosis and treatment

Students will attend two to four didactic conferences each week. Students will demonstrate attainment of the above objectives through attendance and participation in didactic conferences and attendance at clinical assignments and participation in clinical activities.
