#### THE COMMENCEMENT PROCESSION

The Commencement processional includes members of the academic community of McGovern Medical School at The University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston, honors recipients, and distinguished guests.

The Chief Marshal leads the processional which includes: Student Marshal; candidates for the Doctor of Medicine degree; Faculty Marshal; members of the Medical School faculty; President of the graduating class; the speaker; Vice Deans and Associate Deans; Dean; and President of the Health Science Center.

The wearing of academic costume by those in the processional is a tradition preserved from medieval universities. Originally, the gowns were worn for warmth in unheated buildings, and the hoods covered the tonsured head.

Academic dress, adopted by American institutions during the last century, follows a code of regulations which makes it possible to distinguish the degree received and the institution awarding the degree. The doctor's gown has bell-shaped sleeves banded in velvet. Its color is black or can be the academic color of the degree granting institution. All hoods are lined in the institution's colors. (The academic colors of The University of Texas are burnt orange and white.) The bindings of the hood designate the degree earned, for example, green for medicine or golden yellow for science.

The Chief Marshal, who is the senior member of the McGovern Medical School faculty, carries the Health Science Center's mace.

# Serena Auñón-Chancellor, M.D., PH.D. Biography



Dr. Serena M. Auñón-Chancellor joined Johnson Space Center in August 2006, employed as a Flight Surgeon under the UTMB/ Wyle Bioastronautics contract. She was selected in July 2009 as one of 14 members of the 20th NASA astronaut class. A 2011 graduate of Astronaut Candidate Training, a program that included scientific and technical briefings, intensive instruction in space station systems, spacewalks, robotics, physiological training, T-38 flight training and water and wilderness survival training, she went on to spend two months in Antarctica from 2010 to 2011 searching for meteorites as part of the ANSMET expedition. Most

of that time was spent living on the ice 200 nautical miles from the South Pole. In 2012, Dr. Auñón-Chancellor operated the Deep Worker submersible as part of the NEEMO 16 mission. She subsequently served as an Aquanaut aboard the Aquarius underwater laboratory during the NEEMO 20 undersea exploration mission. Currently, Dr. Auñón-Chancellor spends most of her time handling medical issues for both the International Space Station Operations branch and Commercial Crew Branch. She is also certified as an International Space Station CAPCOM and served as the lead Capcom for the SpaceX-4 and SpaceX-8 cargo resupply missions.

Board certified in Internal and Aerospace Medicine, Dr. Auñón-Chancellor recently served as Flight Engineer on the International Space Station for Expeditions 56 and 57. During her time on orbit, the crews contributed to hundreds of experiments in biology, biotechnology, physical science and Earth science aboard the International Space Station. Investigations were led into new cancer treatment methods and algae growth in space. The crew also installed a new Life Sciences Glovebox, a sealed work area for life science and technology investigations that can accommodate two astronauts. She currently covers medical issues and on-orbit support in the Astronaut Office.

Dr. Auñón-Chancellor received a Bachelor of Science in Electrical Engineering from The George Washington University, Washington, D.C., in 1997 and a Doctorate of Medicine from The University of Texas - Health Science Center at Houston in 2001. She completed residency in internal medicine at The University of Texas Medical Branch (UTMB) in Galveston, Texas, in 2004, and then completed an additional year as Chief Resident in the Internal Medicine Department in 2005. She also completed an aerospace medicine residency at UTMB as well as a Master of Public Health in 2007.

Among her awards and honors are the United States Air Force Flight Surgeons Julian Ward Award (2009), the Outstanding UTMB Resident Award (2007), the William K. Douglas Award (2006), membership in Alpha Omega Alpha Honor Society (2005), and the Thomas N. and Gleaves James Award for Excellent Performance by a Third-Year Resident in Internal Medicine (2004). She holds active membership in the American College of Physicians; the American College of Preventive Medicine; the Alpha Omega Alpha Medical Honor Society; the Aerospace Medical Association and Tau Beta Pi, the National Engineering Honor Society.

#### Walter G. Sterling Award for Excellence

The Walter G. Sterling Award for Excellence is given annually to the outstanding graduating senior of the Medical School as chosen by the faculty. The award recipient is the student who has exhibited scholastic superiority, outstanding interpersonal relations, and energy and one who has earned the respect and affection of his or her patients. The award was made possible by a gift from the late Mr. Sterling.

Leonard Tow Humanism in Medicine Award Presented by the Arnold P. Gold Foundation The Truman G. Blocker, Jr., M.D. Gold-Headed Cane Award

The Gold-Headed Cane Award was founded at The University of Texas Medical School at Houston in 1979 by Dr. Truman G. Blocker, Jr., Acting President of the Health Science Center, 1977 and 1978, as a vital memorial to medicine's ideals and ethics embodied in the young physician. Derived from an old English custom that was inaugurated in 1689 by a physician named John Radcliffe, the first Gold-Headed Cane in the United States was awarded in 1929. The Gold-Headed Cane is engraved with the name of the recipient of the award and the words, "Humility, Humanity, and Fidelity." It is clear that the purpose of this award is to honor the *art* of medicine. The award was and continues to be based on the student's interest in the welfare of the patient. The recipient is selected by the graduating class.

do solemnly swear, by whatever I hold most sacred:

That I will be loyal to the profession of medicine and just and generous to its members;

That I will lead my life and practice my profession in uprightness and honor;

That into whatsoever house I shall enter, it shall be for the good of the sick to the utmost of my power, holding myself far aloof from wrong, from corruption, from the tempting of others to vice;

That I will exercise my profession solely for the cure of my patients, and will give no drug, perform no operation, for a criminal purpose, even if solicited, far less suggest it;

That whatsoever I shall see or hear of the lives of men which is not fitting to be spoken, I will keep inviolably secret. These things do I swear.

And now, should I be true to this, my oath, may prosperity and good repute be ever mine; the opposite, should I prove myself forsworn.

#### HISTORY OF THE OATH OF HIPPOCRATES

The Oath of Hippocrates, a brief statement of principles, has come down through history as a living statement of ideals to be cherished by the physician. This Oath was conceived some time during the period of Grecian greatness, probably in the fifth century B.C. It protected rights of the patient and appealed to the inner and finer instincts of the physician without imposing sanctions or penalties on him or her. Other civilizations subsequently developed written principles, but the Oath of Hippocrates (Christianized in the tenth or eleventh century A.D. to eliminate reference to pagan gods) has remained in Western Civilization as an expression of ideal conduct for the physician.

The most significant contribution to Western Medical ethical history subsequent to Hippocrates was made by Thomas Percival, an English physician, philosopher, and writer. In 1803, he published his Code of Medical Ethics. His personality, his interest in sociological matters, and his close association with the Manchester infirmary led to the preparation of a "scheme of professional conduct relative to hospitals and other charities" from which he drafted the code which bears his name.

At the first official meeting of the American Medical Association at Philadelphia in 1847, the two principal items of business were the establishment of a code of ethics and the creation of minimum requirements for medical education and training. Although the Medical Society of the State of New York and the Medico-Chirurgical Society of Baltimore had formal written codes of medical ethics prior to this time, it is clear the AMA's first adopted Code of Ethics was based on Percival's Code.

In general, the language and concepts of the original Code adopted by the Association in 1847 remained the same throughout the years. There were revisions, of course, which reflected the temper of the times and the eternal quest to express basic concepts with clarity. Major revisions did occur in 1903, 1912, and 1947.

In December 1955, an attempt was made to distinguish medical ethics from matters of etiquette. A draft of a two-part code seeking to accomplish this was submitted to the House of Delegates at that time but was not accepted. This proposal was, in effect, a separation of then existing statements found in the Principles into two categories. Little or no change was made in the language of the forty-eight sections of the Principles.

Subsequently, in June 1956, a seemingly radical proposal was submitted to the House of Delegates for consideration. This proposal, a short version of the Principles, was discussed at the December 1956 session of the House after wide publication and broad consideration among members of the medical profession. It was postponed for final consideration until the June 1957 meeting of the House of Delegates, when the short version was adopted.

The format of the Principles adopted in June 1957 is a change from the format of the principles promulgated by Percival in 1803 and accepted by the Association in 1847. Ten short sections, preceded by a preamble, "succinctly expresses the fundamental concepts embodied in the present (1955) Principles," according to the report of the Council on Constitution and bylaws. That Council assured the House of Delegates in its June 1957 report that "every basic principle has been preserved; on the other hand, as much as possible of the prolixity and ambiguity which in the past obstructed ready explanation, practical codification and particular selection of basic concepts has been eliminated."

In 1977 the Judicial Council recommended to the House of Delegates that the AMA Principles of Medical Ethics be revised to clarify and update the language, to eliminate reference to gender, and to seek a proper and reasonable balance between professional standards and contemporary legal standards in our changing society. Given the desire of the Judicial Council for a new version of the Principles to be widely accepted and accurately understood, in 1978 the Judicial Council recommended that a special committee of the House be appointed to consider such a revision. This was done in 1980, and the House of Delegates adopted the revision of the AMA Principles of Medical Ethics.

In June 1985, the Judicial Council became the Council on Ethical and Judicial Affairs.
