WHO

- (4/26) WHO Assistant Director General Mariângela Simão [announced](#) during a press conference that the expert committee providing vaccine recommendations to WHO will assess vaccines from Sinopharm and Sinovac. Specifically, they will have a decision in the next two weeks whether these vaccines should be listed for emergency use.
- (4/26) While immunization services start recovering from disruptions caused by the pandemic, Gavi, the Vaccine Alliance [highlighted](#) the need to bolster lifesaving routine childhood vaccinations, especially for measles, yellow fever, and polio. **Measles programs account for 23 of the postponed campaigns, which affect an estimated 140 million people.**
