even if you're fully vaccinated



If you feel sick or have any COVID-19 symptoms



If you have been around someone with COVID-19



After spending time in a large crowd or enclosed space without a mask



When requested by your school, workplace, healthcare provider, or local government

HELP STOP THE SPREAD

You can spread COVID-19 to your loved ones, even if you're vaccinated or feel fine



Get your vaccine and booster as soon as possible, even if you've had COVID-19



Wear a mask in public and social distance when possible



Go to a COVID-19 testing site or take a self-test when needed



Unvaccinated COVID-19 patients have a greater risk of hospitalization and death
